



What to Do if You Blow the Answer to an Interview Question

Strategies to improve your interview...after you leave!

After 11 years out of the full-time workforce, I had the opportunity to interview for a great job at an investment firm. Part of the interview process was to answer “case interview” questions, each asked by a different interviewer.
